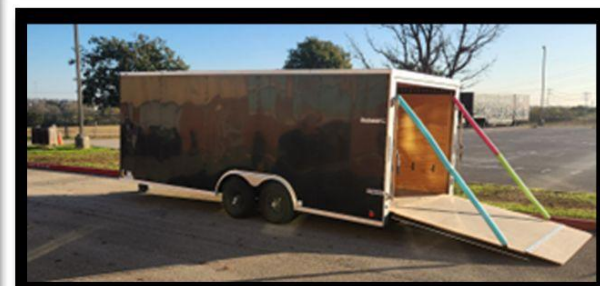
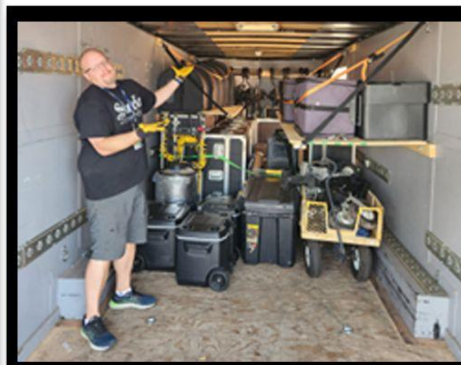
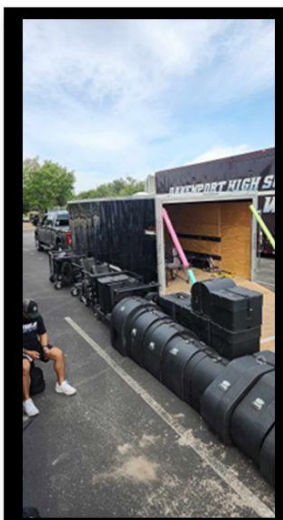
What is a Truck Boss?

- Identifies Maintenance Issues

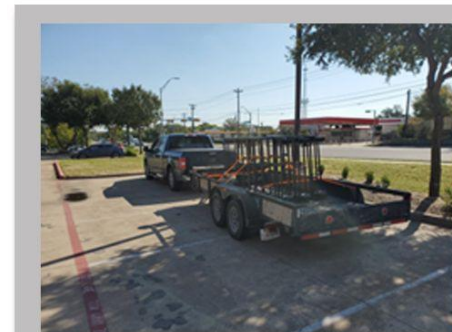


2-Person Crew



Truck Driver Duties:

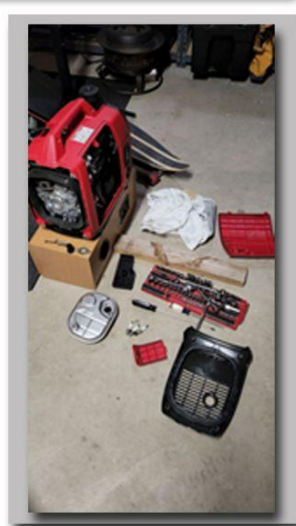
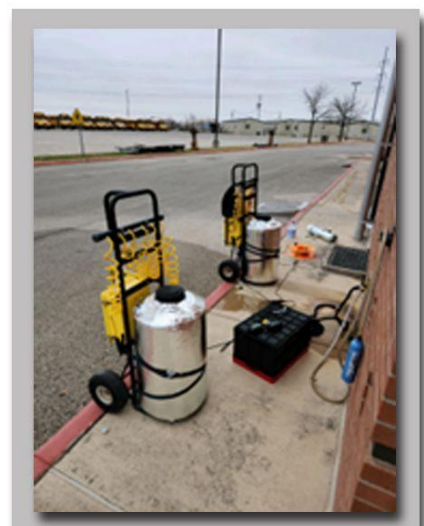
- Responsible for driving the booster trailer

Truck Driver

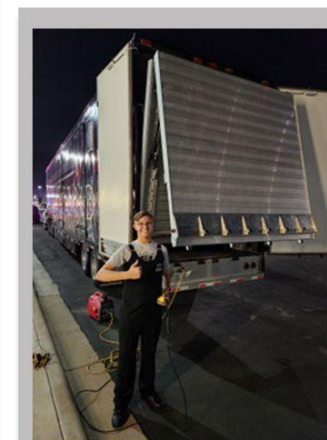
- Can support ALL Football games and Competitions (early arrivals / late departures)
